Passport 2010 is a series of 11 guided walks led by the Greensand Trust, throughout the year. We'll be exploring a range of habitats from woodlands to heathlands, discovering wildlife, including birds, mammals and butterflies, and seasonal plants.



We'll also be introducing people to the Greensand Ridge Walk trail with several longer walks accompanied by our ranger.



The Passport will entitle holders to attend walks and make a saving of more than half the cost of booking separately! Costs per walk if booked separately will be £2 per adult and £1 per child for half day walks, £3 per adult and £1 per child for full day walks.
