

## OXENHOLME

Leave station from exit by the ticket office. Walk past the station car park and then continue left, following the road up hill. The **Station Inn** is 600m on your left.

## KENDAL

For the **Castle Inn**, turn left at the end of the approach road to the station and cross the road at the traffic lights, turn right and then left down Ann Street and right into Castle Street.

For the **Riverside Hotel**, leave the station and cross the road directly in front of you, continue up past the County Hotel on to Wildman Street, continue along this road. The Riverside Hotel is on your right.

Follow the directions to the Riverside Hotel and continue along Stramongate over the river. Bear left, using the pedestrian crossings to follow New Road along the river. Stay on this side of the river and after the road turns right into Lowther Street, **Burgundy's** is 100m ahead on your left.

## STAVELEY

For **Hawkshead Brewery** and **the Eagle and Child** take the road directly opposite the station entrance and walk down the lane.

For the **Brewery**, cross the footbridge at the bottom of the lane, turn left on to Main Street, and the Mill Yard is on your right after the Spar shop.

For **the Eagle and Child**, turn right at the footbridge and follow the lane.

**The Watermill** at Ings is a 15 minute walk from Staveley along the A591 or a short bus ride on the 555 from bus stops in Staveley or Windermere.

## WINDERMERE

Turn left out of station. After the Tourist Information Centre turn left taking the right fork onto High Street. **Lamplighters** is on your right.

Go back up High Street take the left fork until the second left turning which is Cross Street the **Elleray** is on this road.

*Westmorland Camra is proud to be promoting fabulous real ales with responsible travel in the Lake District. Leave the car behind and use the Lakes Line to visit some wonderful real ale pubs. All are within easy walking distance of Lakes Line stations, with the exception of the Watermill Inn at Ings. Unless otherwise stated all pubs are a 5 minute, or less, walk from the station.*

The stops along the Lakes Line offer many attractions as well as great real ale pubs. In Kendal you could visit the Castle, pop into the vibrant Brewery Arts Centre, take a walk down the River Kent or enjoy one of Kendal's great museums. Travel into the Lake District National Park, and visit Staveley for walking and mountain biking in the beautiful Kentmere Valley. In Windermere visit the Lake and enjoy a cruise with Windermere Lake Cruises or walk up to Orrest Head to see one of the best views in the Lake District.

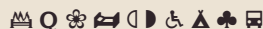
