**Take a trip back in time to the 1760s when wealth and power enabled the creation of this outstanding house and beautiful landscaped park, all designed to impress and amaze visitors - just as Kedleston continues to do so today.**

Our 18th Century housekeeper, Mrs Garnett, welcomes you to the Hall, where you can discover the most complete sequence of Robert Adam interiors in the country containing their original furniture and paintings. Downstairs, the Eastern Museum is full of fascinating objects collected by Lord Curzon on his travels through Asia.

Four different walks allow you to explore the 800 acre park, while the garden has been restored to an 18th century Pleasure Ground full of interesting trees and plants.

Visitors during 2008 can enjoy tours of the Fishing Pavilion, Stables and Gardens (selected dates and times). The refurbished Eastern Museum has improved lighting and new interpretation, while the

Smoking Room has been redeveloped as an information and rest facility and includes our new Virtual Tour giving access to the state floor for visitors who are unable to climb the stairs. A variety of events take place at Kedleston Hall throughout the year.
