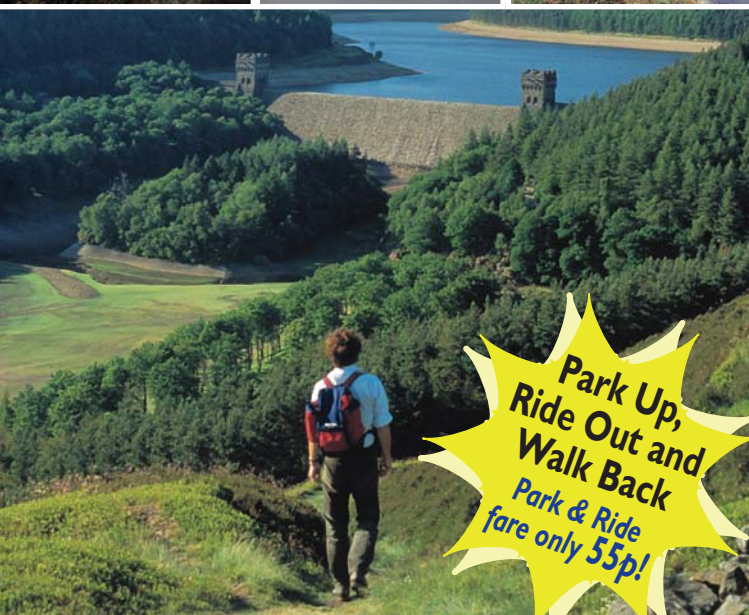

Welcome to the Upper Derwent Valley.

Once you've parked up, there's a great way to see the Valley – by hopping on one of the frequent Upper Derwent park & ride bus services.

Bus 222 runs on Bank Holiday Mondays, Summer Weekends, and Winter Sundays - when the road from Fairholmes to the road's end at King's Tree is closed to car traffic - making bus 222 the most convenient way to explore the beautiful northern part of the valley.

Bus 222 is ideal for going walking – instead of doing a circular walk from your car, why not use the bus to ride out and then walk back, without retracing your steps?



Where to catch bus 222 from Fairholmes

TM Travel bus 222 departs from the bus stop located on Derwent Lane. Access is by a short walk on a path that leads direct to the bus stop from the upper level car park at Fairholmes. Bus 222 operates as 'Hail and Ride' between Fairholmes and King's Tree – you may flag down the bus from any safe point along the route.

Bus 222 also serves bus stops adjacent to other car parks in the area – see map on rear cover.

At Fairholmes Information Centre (Tel. 01433 650953) you will find everything you need to know about visiting this special area. There is also a snack bar next to the centre.

Fairholmes to King's Tree

The road between Fairholmes and King's Tree is closed to car traffic on Summer Weekends, Bank Holiday Mondays and Winter Sundays – making Bus 222 the only way to explore this area. The bus also serves other car parks as shown.

Bus 222 is a Hail and Ride service which will stop at any safe place on request.

Only 55p (Child/Concession half) takes you past Derwent and Howden Dams to the end of the road at King's Tree!
