The Derwent Valley Line is operated by East Midlands Trains as part of their train services across the East Midlands. The Journey time to Matlock from Derby is 32 minutes. Matlock benefits from an hourly train service from an Derby and Nottingham. Relax and enjoy the picturesque landscape as the train brings you into Matlock through the picturesque Derwent Valley Mills World Heritage Site.

Dale Road became a popular shopping area with visitors who came to Matlock for

the many different water treatments.

Hotels, pubs, a market hall, jewellers and clothes shops lined either side of the road.

Over the last 150 years Matlock has grown and developed to accommodate visitors and locals looking for all the services and choice we came to expect in our local town centre. The shopping areas have extended to take in Causeway Lane, Crown Square, Firs Parade and Matlock Green.

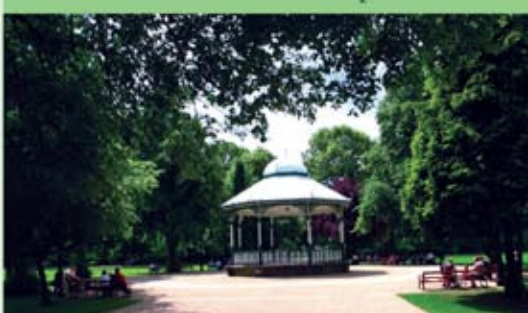
A 'shop local' campaign is breathing new life into Matlock and as part of that we invite you to sample and support the produce and products on offer at an enviable range of independent shops and local services.



There is so much to explore in and around Matlock using public transport. Hop on the bus or train and enjoy the scenery at your leisure. Matlock has developed hugely from its transport links. River, canal, tram, road and rail have all had a major influence. From Matlock, the scenic Peak District and its picturesque villages are a virtual ride away. Matlock Bath provides a great family day out with its many attractions or discover the Derwent Valley Mills World Heritage Site. All Tickets are valid for one-day from first bus to last bus and on trains after 0900 (or at any time if a Saturday, Sunday or Bank Holiday Monday). Regular bus services operate making Matlock easily accessible by bus from surrounding towns

Throughout the year, events in and around Matlock provide something to suit every taste;

- Farmers' markets are held in the Imperial Rooms on the 3rd Saturday of every month. Local suppliers and producers supply a wide range of organic meat, produce, bread, cakes and crafts.
- Matlock Live! is held in July and is a celebration of performing and visual arts in and around Matlock.
- On Sunday afternoons from June until the end of August Brass Band Concerts provide entertainment in Hall Leys Park.
- Victorian Matlock Christmas Weekend is always held on the first weekend of December and is a celebrated

event offering family entertainment, a magical parade and a spectacular fireworks display. Here you can buy local produce and crafts and enjoy a feast of family entertainment.

■ The Boxing Day raft race is another local tradition not to be missed with entrants travelling from far and wide to fill the River Derwent with their fantastic and imaginative creations.

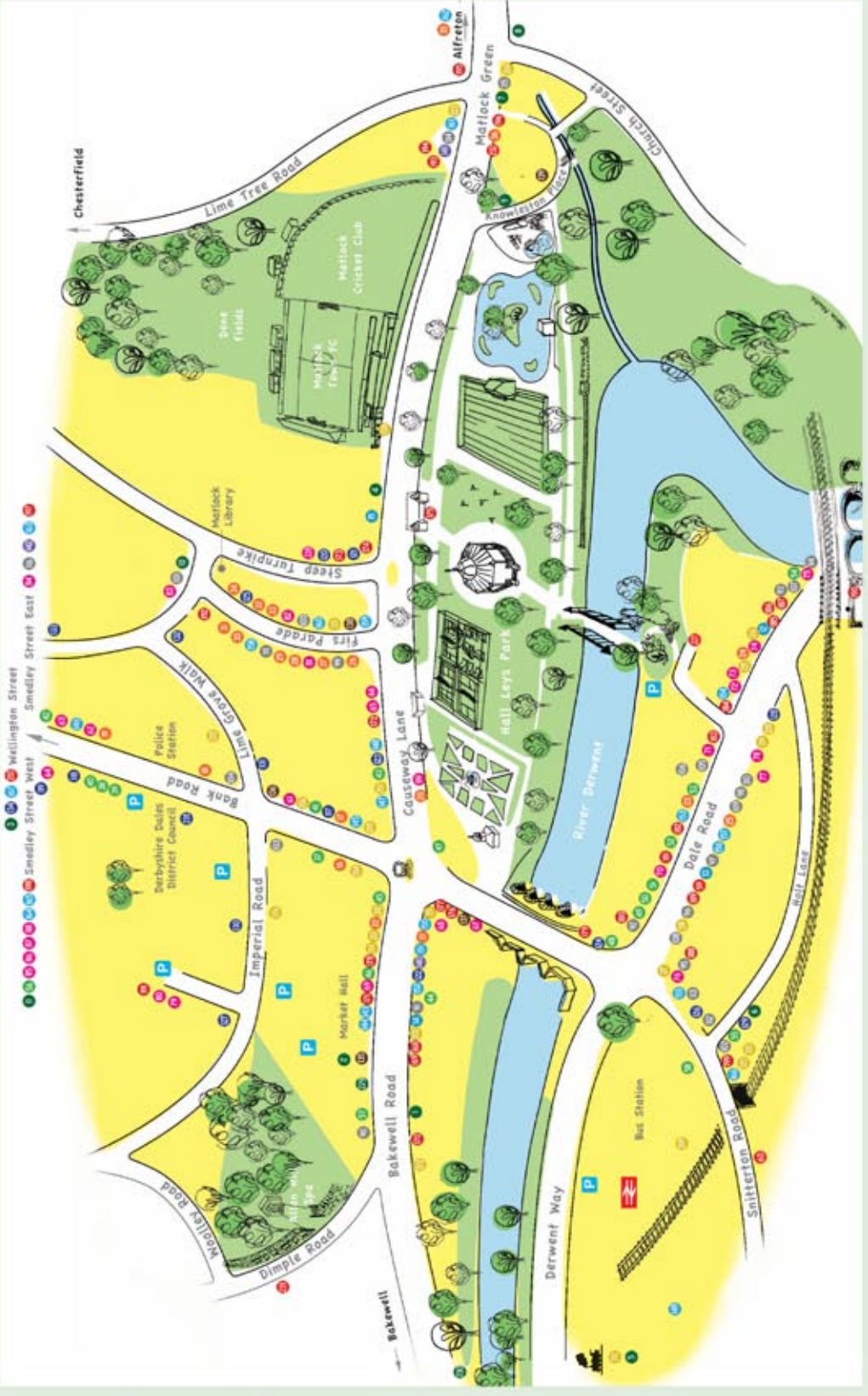
