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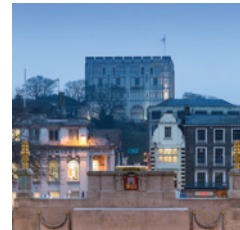

SEVEN DAY TOUR

Immerse yourself in the full story of the American Friendly Invasion with this comprehensive seven-day tour of eastern England.

DAY
1

Begin the tour in **Norwich**. Visit the **Second Air Division Memorial Library**, Norwich Cathedral and Castle. Stay overnight at the historic Maids Head Hotel.



DAY
2

Visit two museums devoted to America's wartime presence: **100th Bomb Group Memorial Museum**, Thorpe Abbots, Norfolk - 'Bloody Hundredth'; **95th Bomb Group**, Horham, Suffolk, site of recent archaeological excavations of Second World War items and the Red Feather Club. Stay overnight at the Lavenham Swan, home of the Airmen's Bar.



DAY
3

Drive through **Constable Country** (Dedham Vale) to Stoke by Nayland. Spend the day relaxing in the spa or enjoying golf at one of the two championship courses, set in 300 acres of countryside in an Area of Outstanding Beauty.



DAY
4

Visit the 'White House', Hylands House, near **Chelmsford**. Have a traditional British cuppa at Writtle Tea Rooms and explore Chelmsford Cathedral's American links. Spend the night in Cambridge.



DAY
5

Get the full picture of The Friendly Invasion at the American Air Museum, **IWM Duxford**, and **Cambridge American Cemetery and Memorial**. Drive to **Grantham**, Lincolnshire. Overnight at Victorian mansion Stoke Rockford Hall Hotel.

DAY
6

Visit **RAF Scampton**, home of the Red Arrows aerobatic team. Explore the historic city of **Lincoln**. Drive to **Heacham**, Norfolk, and see the mulberry tree which legend has it was planted by Pocahontas. Overnight at Heacham Manor.

DAY
7

Call in at **Sandringham Estate**, the much-loved country retreat of Queen Elizabeth II and the Royal Family. On to the coast at **Sheringham** to see the North Norfolk Railway. Climb Beeston Bump, where you can see remains of military fortifications, before returning to Norwich to spend the night. (Day 8: Depart Norwich).
