

## Maldon Millennium Meander

Route chosen and waymarked by the Chelmer and Blackwater Group of the Ramblers Association in 1991 to mark the 1000<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the battle of Maldon 991AD.



The battle of Maldon took place where the causeway to Northey Island meets the mainland.

Byrhtnoth, Eardorman of Essex was slain during the battle and his Anglo - Saxon army defeated by the Viking invaders.

A statue commemorating Byrhtnoth can be seen in the Promenade Park.

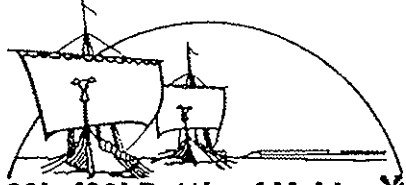

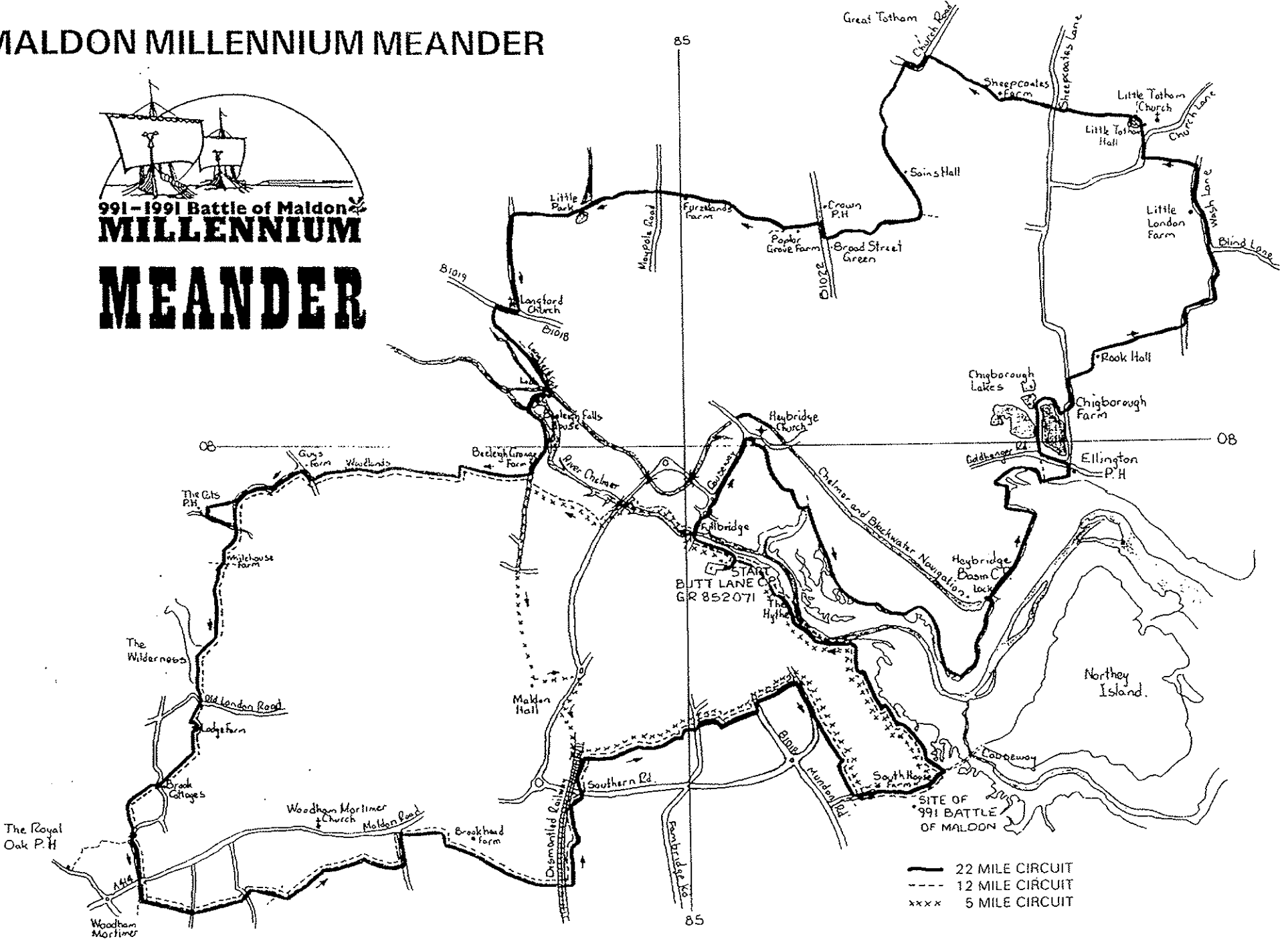
