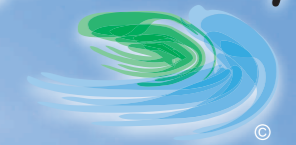

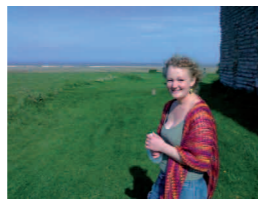

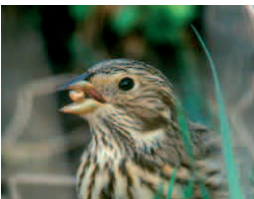
Thames Sailing Barges at Maldon's Hythe Quay.
