GUIDED HERITAGE WALKS

Medieval Town Wall

Discover who built England's second most complete Medieval Town Wall, why Great Yarmouth needed it and all about the historic maritime town that formed inside it.
Starts: St Nicholas' Church gates, close to Market Place
Length of walk: Approx 1½ hrs–2 hrs

Rows, Fishwives and Body snatchers

The unique Great Yarmouth Rows leading from quay to Market Place housed wealthy merchants at one end, and bars and fisher girls at the other. Find out how the two mixed on this fascinating tour.
Starts: St. Nicholas' Church gates, close to the Market Place
Length of walk: Approx 1½ hrs–2 hrs

Sea, Sand and Spending a Penny

Explore the history behind Great Yarmouth's Golden Mile, where bathing machines and docking ships once fought for space on the beach, WWII bombs were found and fashion trends for seaside bathing were established next to Victorian loos and homes for shipwrecked sailors.
Starts: Tourist Information Centre, Marine Parade
Length of walk: Approx 1½ hrs

28–29 MAY: The Graveyard Walk

From the graveyard to the cemetery, discover fascinating stories of where sailors, merchants and circus owners were laid to rest.
Starts: St. Nicholas' Church gates

24–25 SEPTEMBER: Lydia Eva & Historic South Quay

Great Yarmouth's historic South Quay was where many townfolk made their fishing fortune. Find out more about this vibrant industry and the beautifully restored last steam drifter, the Lydia Eva.
Starts: Town Hall
Length of walk: Approx 1½ hrs plus time on the Lydia Eva

29–30 OCTOBER: Halloween Weekend

Give yourself the spooks with strange stories of gruesome activities and ghoulish finds, murder, monks and witches.
Starts: St. Nicholas' Church gates
Length of walk: Approx 1½ hrs
