Morning: Wood Green Animal Shelter, Kings Bush Farm, London Road, Godmanchester, PE29 2NH

The shelter in Godmanchester is set in 52 acres of beautiful countryside and is one of the largest animal rehoming centres for cats, dogs, field animals and small animals in Europe. It boasts extensive modern animal care facilities including a heated kennel block and purpose built cattery.

We also have a coffee shop, pet and gift shop, thrift shop, picnic site, lake, children's play area and water garden. The charity's trading arm also has extensive facilities that are available for hire, ideal for conferences and wedding fairs and ceremonies, with all profits from events going back into the care of animals.

Afternoon: Raptor Foundation, Woodhurst

On the B1040 between St Ives and Somersham. Follow the brown and white signs.

The Raptor Foundation is the permanent home to over 200 birds. Make a visit and get close to nature's most endearing and stunning creatures: owls, hawks, falcons and even some parrots. Then rest in the gardens with the gentle sound of running water and scented flowers or watch and feed the Koi in the pond.

The Raptor Foundation prides itself in being wheelchair accessible. With three daily flying displays, you can see how silently an owl flies and the speed of the falcons. The Foundation also runs various falconry courses to suit your expertise.

Also on site is the "Silent Wings" tearoom which is open to the public as well as visitors from 10am – 3pm each day and offers a wide selection of hot and cold food.

The Foundation is a must for photographers, painters and lovers of owls.
