3	Broad Beans	plate of 5 of one variety
4	Beetroot	plate of 3 of one variety
5	Courgettes	plate of 2 with flower of one variety
6	Asparagus	plate of 5 of one variety
7	Cabbage	plate of 2 of one variety
8	Radishes	plate of 5 of one variety
9	Lettuce	plate of 2 of one variety
10	Carrots	plate of 5 of one variety
11	Peas	plate of 9 of one variety
12	A plate of 6 vegetables, mixed or same kind	

FRUIT

13	Gooseberries	plate of 9 of one variety with stalks
14	Raspberries	plate of 9 of one variety with stalks
15	Strawberries	plate of 9 of one variety with stalks

FLOWERS

16	Sweet Peas	9 sprays per vase (provide vase)
17	A Single Rose	including minimum 3" stem and fern (corsage)
18	A vase of Mixed Flowers – 9 flowers minimum 3 varieties

SHOW RULES

1. All produce entered in the show must have been grown and/or made by the exhibitor
2. Not more than one entry from any one allotment, garden or household in any one class
3. Entries for the show must reach Eastbourne Borough Council by Friday 11 May 2012
4. All exhibits must be staged by 1100 hours on the day of the show. All exhibits must have class cards obtainable from the Blooming Marvellous Co-Ordinator on show day. No responsibility can be taken for loss of cards on exhibits or exhibits staged in the wrong class.
5. No entries will be accepted on the day of the show and exhibitors may NOT substitute one entry for another.
6. All entries are £1 per class
7. Any exhibits in the competition staged without the appropriate card will be disqualified. Exhibitors must not remove other exhibitor's entries on the show bench without authority from the Blooming Marvellous Co-Ordinator.
8. No show cards may be removed from the show until after 5.00 p.m. when the show ends.
9. All exhibits must be to show standard.
10. The decision of the judges is final. RHS guidelines will be used for exhibits where appropriate.
11. All flower exhibitors must provide their own vase.
