The site is close to both the Dotto Train stop offering a regular promenade service to the Pier and the Stagecoach bus stop offering a ½ hourly service (99) on Saturday and an hourly service on Sunday into Eastbourne.

This site offers our exhibitors a safe, flat grassy area on which to display either independently or as a club stand.

Entrants must pay proper regard to the Stewards' instructions and conduct themselves in a manner which will not inconvenience other persons on the site.

All exhibits attending the event must be insured.
