

Trail User Notes 01/06/17

On this page we post notes about sections of the trail of which users should be aware:

1. Improvements to the trail quality have recently been made to the section through Torbreck Woods. Much more though remains to be done and users should be prepared for crossing sections of trail here which are very boggy
2. There is now an alternative route available between the Witches Burn (314402) and the village of Dores, which takes users off road for most of the distance, following a track through woodland and along the side of open fields. However, the trail here requires more work to bring it up to standard and is not yet waymarked
3. The section of trail between Inverfarigaig and Foyers is not suitable for cyclists or horse riders. Please instead follow the route via Glen Lia (Gleann Liath)
4. There is a small section of way marked only trail on the Whitebridge side of the bridge over the river at Ardochy. However, the line of the trail is clear.
5. At the top of the Corkscrew be aware that there are a few fields with cattle which are not contained by fences and are often on the trail route.
6. Our downloadable maps (PDF's) are produced in colour, and the trail is highlighted in yellow which does not render well in black and white. For this reason to avoid confusion we strongly recommended that you print off the maps on our website with a colour printer.
