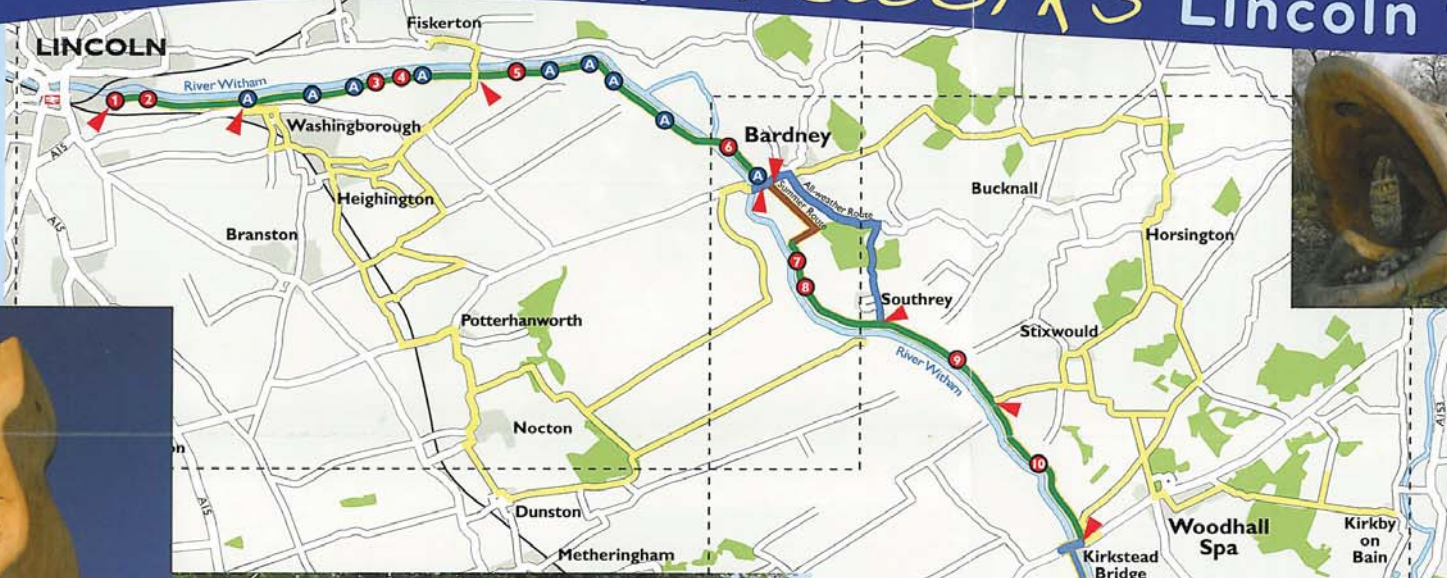


Water Rail Way artworks Lincoln to Boston



Code of Conduct for Shared Use Paths

Cyclists Please don't expect to cycle at high speeds and be prepared to slow down or stop if necessary. Be careful at junctions, bends and entrances. Give way to walkers, wheelchair users and horse riders - leaving them plenty of room. Remember that many people cannot hear or see well so don't assume that they can see or hear you. Fit a bell and use it - don't surprise people.

Motorbikes Are not permitted on the path.

Horse Riders Please proceed at a walking pace to protect the surface of the path for other users, and allow families with young children to use the path in comfort.

Walkers If you are walking with a dog, please keep it on a lead at all times.
