

Shakespeare Experience Itinerary

Sample I

Day One

Group to arrive into Stratford under independent arrangements. On arrival check in to local guest houses:

Guest House 1 Evesham Place Stratford	Split: 1 quad (4 girls) 2 triples (6 girls) 2 twins (4 girls) 1 single (1 adult)
Guest House 2 Evesham Place Stratford	Split: 2 triples (6 girls) 1 twin (2 girls) 1 single (1 adult)
Guest House 3 Evesham Place Stratford	Split: 2 triples (6 girls) 1 twin (2 girls) 2 singles (2 adults)

One single also provided for driver at a nearby Guest House.

13.00-16.00 Drama workshop with professional theatre personnel. Group to be split as follows:

17.30 Evening meal to be included at local restaurant.

19.30 Theatre performance – TBA

Day Two

Day One

Group to arrive at Stratford Youth Hostel under independent arrangements. Check in on arrival as follows:

- 13.30 Introductory talk and visit to Shakespeare's Birthplace. Entrance vouchers will be supplied.
- 15.15 A 30 minute boat trip on the River Avon.
- 16.00 Wigs & Makeup session with an RSC make-up professional. Session will last one hour.
- 17.00 Coach will meet the groups at the Methodist Main Hall for a transfer to Stratford Youth Hostel.
- 18.30 Evening meal will be served at the youth hostel.

Day Two

- 09.00 Coach and local guide will meet the group at the Youth Hostel for a tour of Stratford upon Avon. Entrance is included to Anne Hathaway's Cottage and Mary Arden's Farm. The guide will have the relevant entrance vouchers.
- 12.00 Tour will terminate and group have free time for lunch (not included).
- 13.00 Brass Rubbing at Stratford Brass Rubbing Centre. A short talk will be given first, followed by the opportunity for all to do a small brass rubbing. Due to numbers group to be split as follows:

- 09.00-10.30 A – Drama workshop with professional theatre personnel.
B – Visit to Falstaffs Experience, including introductory talk and guided tour.
- 10.30-12.00 A – Visit to Falstaffs Experience, including introductory talk and guided tour.

- Free time for lunch (not included).
- 13.30 Coach to collect the group from the Birthplace Coach Park for a transfer to Heritage Motor Centre. Tour of the museum and optional go-karting or 4x4 experience. Return transfer is included at 16.30hrs.
