YSP offers a range of fascinating talks and guided tours for all ages, abilities and interests:

### **Underground Gallery Talk** Free (no minimum) (during exhibitions only)

This free introductory talk is the perfect start to your visit. Gain an insight into the latest exhibition in the stunning, award-winning Underground Gallery, located a one minute walk from the Visitor Centre.

### **Sculpture and Landscape Tour** £5 per person (min. 10)

This outdoor walking tour will take your group into the fascinating, historical landscape. With the help of our experienced guides, explore a range of sculpture on display, from monumental works by Henry Moore to inspiring pieces by Andy Goldsworthy and Barbara Hepworth.

Suitable footwear must be worn. Approximately one hour.

### **Curatorial Tours** £10 per person (min. 20)

These specialist tours are led by YSP curators and provide an academic insight into the collection and programme. There are a variety of tours and talks available and these can be tailored to suit your specific group interest. Excludes weekends. Approximately one hour.

Tours are suitable for groups of up to thirty visitors and must be pre-booked. If there are more than thirty in your group please discuss a second tour when making your booking.

All tours are subject to availability.

Suitable footwear and clothing are recommended for all outdoor tours.

## Yorkshire Sculpture Park

### Make the most of your visit

As well as lakes, vistas, 18th Century estate buildings and bridges to explore, there are at least 40 sculptures in the landscape all year round, and changing special exhibitions in 4 indoor galleries. You could spend up to three hours exploring the Park on your own, or maximise your time with one of our suggested routes:

**1 hour:** visit the Formal garden and galleries

**2 hours:** enjoy a tour of the Underground Gallery or take a guided walk around the sculptures in the landscape, then wander back to the restaurant for coffee and cake.

**3 hours:** Buy an 'essential sculpture guide' and use it to explore the sculpture displays. Meander through the Henry Moore bronzes in the Country Park, follow the walking route to Longside Gallery, and return by the shuttle bus for lunch in the restaurant.

### What to wear

We recommend all members of your group wear clothing and footwear suitable for the great outdoors.
