## starts outside The Forum


11am and 2pm on Good Friday (25) and Easter Saturday (26).

**11am, Friday 6 May**




# CATHEDRAL QUARTER

## starts at Norwich Cathedral's Erpingham Gate

This walk takes you past the old warehouses and docks of a bygone era alongside the meandering River Wensum, past some of the most picturesque scenery of Norwich including the famously beautiful Pull's Ferry.
