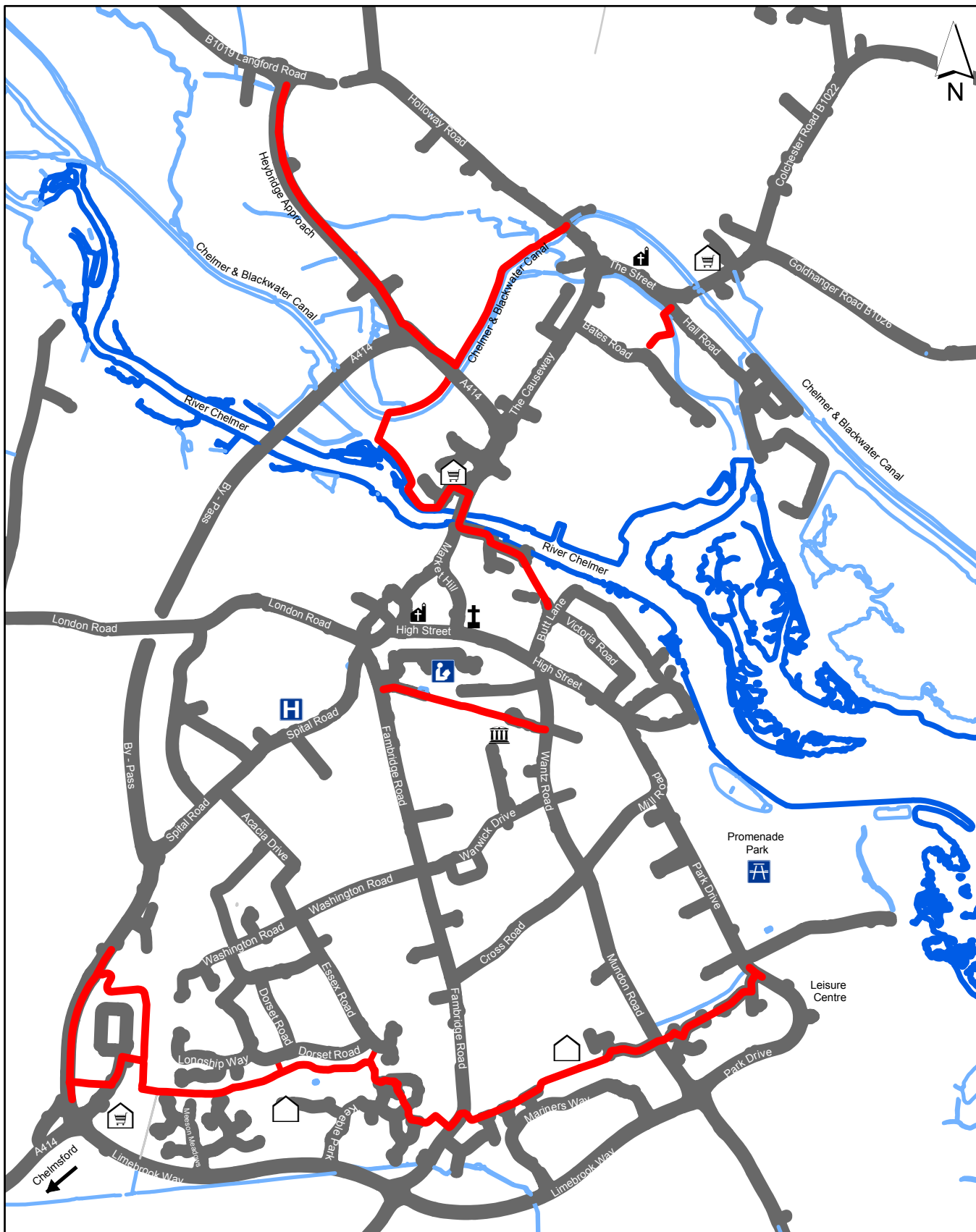


# Maldon and Heybridge Routes for Cyclists
