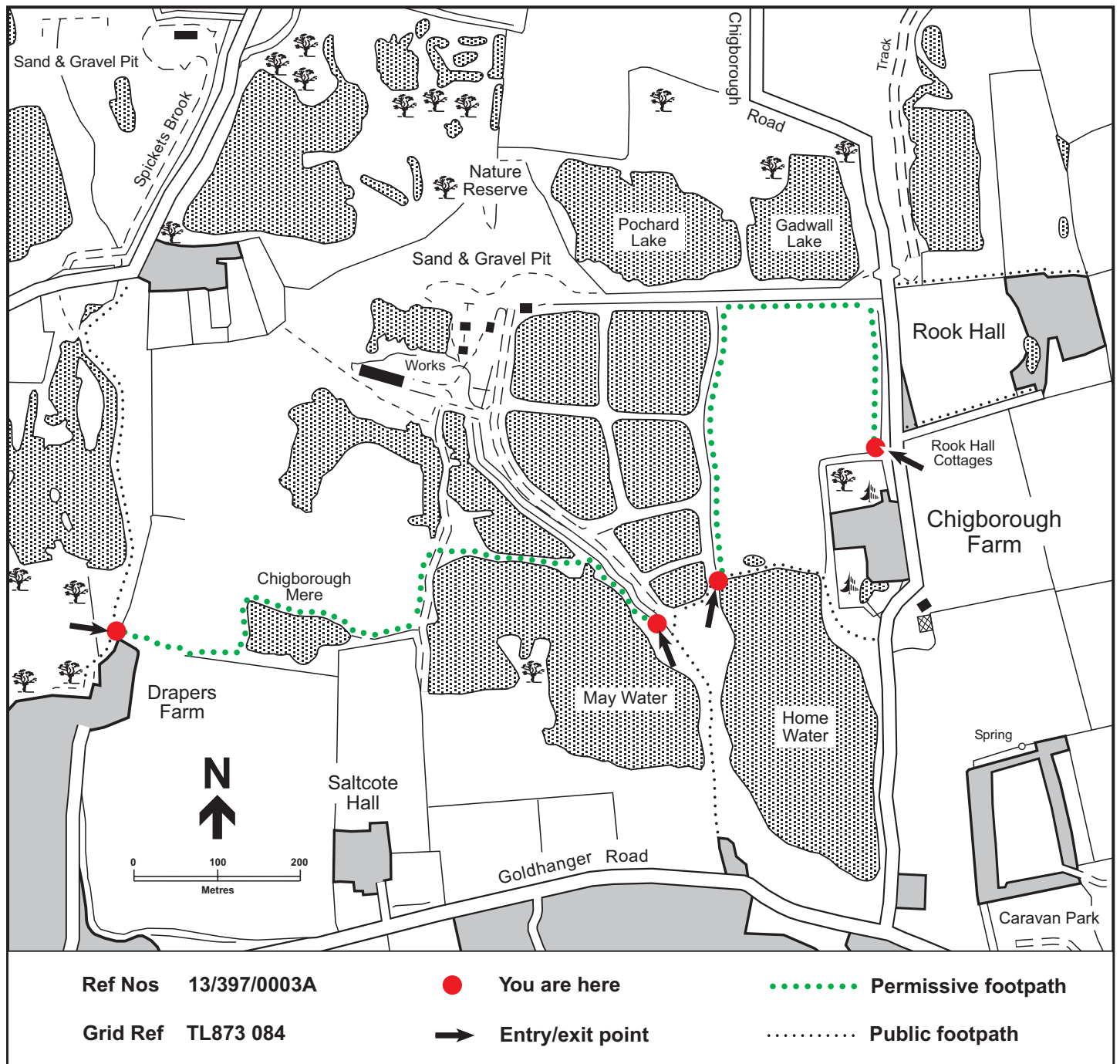


# CONSERVATION WALKS

These permissive footpaths allow walkers to access the lake area and to appreciate the varied wildlife present. They link with the existing public rights of way and partly follow the line of grass margins which are established to protect the field boundary from arable operations and to provide a wildlife refuge. Please keep to a narrow path and ensure dogs are under strict control.



This access has been provided under the Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs' farm conservation schemes, which help farmers and land managers protect and improve the countryside, its wildlife and history. It is permissive access and no new rights of way are being created. Existing rights of way are not affected. Please follow the Country Code and observe any other requirements shown above. Do not disturb wildlife, livestock or other visitors and in particular keep dogs under control. This is working farmland so please take care; people using this site do so at their own risk. Access ends in September 2011.
