Season Tickets

The X roving ticket does not reserve a parking place but when displayed allows a vehicle to park in certain long stay car parks. The other season ticket relates to specific car parks and does reserve a parking space. A pre-paid smart card, similar to a phone card, is also available for purchasing daily parking tickets instead of using cash. The Gateway Car Parks

Visitors to Chichester are encouraged to use the 'Gateway' car parks. These have plenty of spaces close to the heart of the City within easy walking distance of the shopping centre – these are your 'gateways' to Chichester:



Avenue de Chartres Car Park

This award winning modern decked car park is ideally located for those approaching the City from the west, along the A27 from Portsmouth or south from Bognor, the Witterings and Selsey. It is a light airy building which provides some of the best views of the Cathedral. Highly recommended for visitor parking.



Northgate Car Park

Close to the world famous Festival Theatre this car park is most convenient for those driving from north of the Downs (Midhurst & Petworth area).

Cattle Market Car Park

This attractive car park serves those travelling from the east along the A27 from Arundel. On Wednesdays and Saturdays part of the car park is used by the bustling traders' market.



On Street Voucher Parking

On street voucher parking is a method of paying for on street parking and operates:

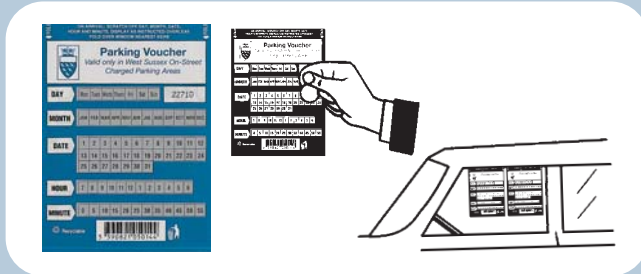
Monday-Saturday, 9.00am-5.30pm

Vouchers cost 20p, 40p, 50p and 60p each and are available individually or in books of ten. They can be obtained from a wide variety of outlets throughout Chichester, including the Tourist Information Centre or where this sign is displayed.

The parking charge is £1.20 per hour (20p per 10 minutes).

The maximum length of stay is one hour.

Blue (Disabled) Badge holders are not subject to time limits or payment when parked in a voucher parking bay. Motor cycles can be parked without charge.



How it works

Voucher parking is simple – upon arrival you should scratch off five panels on the parking voucher(s) to indicate your arrival time.

DAY, MONTH, DATE, HOUR, MINUTE (to next five minutes)

When using more than one voucher it is important to scratch off the same time of arrival on all vouchers.

The vouchers should be displayed by folding the top edge of the voucher(s) and hanging it/them inside the vehicle window facing the nearest kerb and not overlapping.

- You are liable to a penalty charge notice if you park beyond your selected parking period: maximum length of stay one hour.
- Vouchers cannot be used in Permit holder only parking places or in car parks.

Please note that the cost of parking vouchers, as outlined above, will take effect from 5th July 2010. For further information, please contact West Sussex County Council.



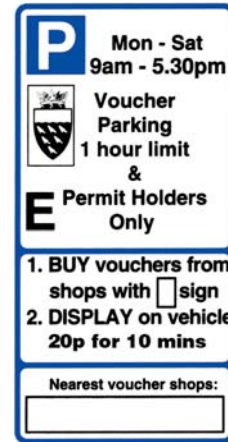
Voucher Parking Zone

Indicates boundaries of the Controlled Parking Zone.



Permit Parking Places

Parking for permit holders only during the hours shown. Parking Vouchers are NOT valid in these spaces.



Shared Parking Places

Parking for up to one hour for vehicles displaying the required number of valid parking vouchers. Unlimited parking for resident permit holders. Visitor Permits are NOT valid in these spaces.



Voucher Parking Places

Parking for up to one hour for vehicles displaying valid parking vouchers.

Easy to Use Parking Guide

All of the car parks in Chichester are within easy walking distance of the City Centre. Generally we would recommend that when visiting the City, the Long Stay 'Gateway' car parks (symbol on map) are the best ones to use, they have the largest number of spaces and lowest charges.

However, depending on the reason for your visit, you may prefer to park elsewhere and this leaflet identifies those places where car parking is available, together with the charges that apply, under the following headings:

Short Stay: is for those quick visits under 3 hours

Long Stay: is for visits of 3 or more hours

Voucher Parking: is for short stay on street parking.

Vouchers can be purchased from Council Offices, the Tourist Information Centre and retail outlets displaying the voucher sign.

It is necessary to purchase a ticket on arrival at all car parks.

Français

Tous les parkings de Chichester sont proches du centre ville. En général, nous vous recommandons, lors de votre visite, de vous garer sur les parkings longue durée 'Gateway' (sur la carte). Ce sont les plus spacieux et les moins chers.

Cependant, suivant les raisons de votre visite, vous pouvez préférer vous garer ailleurs et ce dépliant identifie les endroits où vous pouvez vous garer, ainsi que les tarifs appliqués selon les catégories suivantes:

court séjour: pour les visites n'excédant pas 3 heures

long séjour: visites de plus de 3 heures

tickets de parking: pour les courts moments où vous vous gariez dans la rue.

Les bons peuvent être achetés dans les bureaux des Councils ou au TIC (Tourist Information Centre) et chez les détaillants affichant le symbole de ces tickets.

Il faut que vous achetiez un ticket dès votre arrivée dans tous les parkings.

Deutsch

Alle Parkplätze in Chichester befinden sich in unmittelbarer Nähe des Stadtzentrums. Wir empfehlen Ihnen, wenn Sie die Stadt besuchen, die 'Gateway' Parkplätze (für einen längeren Aufenthalt) (Symbol auf der Karte), die die besten sind, da sie die meisten Parkplätze haben und weniger kosten.

Vom Zweck Ihres Besuches abhängig, möchten Sie vielleicht lieber woanders parken, und dieses Flugblatt zeigt Ihnen weitere mögliche Orte, wo Sie Ihr Auto parken können und die zu zahlenden Gebühren unter folgenden Bezeichnungen:-

kurzer Aufenthalt: ist für kurze Besuche unter 3 Stunden

länger Aufenthalt: ist für Besuche von mehr als 3 Stunden

Gutschein: ist für einen kurzen Aufenthalt auf der Straße.

Gutscheine können vom 'Council Office', vom TIC (Tourist Information Centre) und Einzelhandelsgeschäften, die das Gutscheinezeichen ausstellen, gekauft werden.

Gutscheine müssen bei Ankunft an allen Parkplätzen gekauft werden.

Espanol

Todos los aparcamientos de Chichester se hallan situados cerca del centro de la ciudad. En general recomendamos para visitar la ciudad los aparcamientos de larga duración 'Gateway' (identificados en el mapa con una estrella); éstos son los mejores puesto que poseen el mayor número de espacios y las tarifas más bajas para las categorías siguientes.

Sin embargo, dependiendo de la razón para su visita, es posible que prefiera usted aparcar en otro lugar, y este folleto le informa de los lugares donde hay aparcamientos disponibles, junto con las tarifas en vigor, dentro de las siguientes categorías:

Corta duración: para las visitas de menos de 3 horas.

Larga duración: para visitas de más de 3 horas.

Tarjeta de aparcamiento: aparcamiento en la calle para periodos breves.

Las tarjetas se pueden adquirir en las Oficinas del Ayuntamiento, el Centro de Información Turística y los establecimientos autorizados que exhiben el símbolo de la tarjeta.

Es preciso adquirir una tarjeta al llegar a cualquier aparcamiento.

Places of Interest and Visitor Information

The Tourist Information Centre is located in South Street. Open Monday to Saturday (also Sunday and Bank Holidays April-Sept), it has information on places to visit and stay, events in and around Chichester and sells a fine selection of souvenirs.

The Westgate Centre offers a wide range of sporting activities including three swimming pools, one with a 55m water slide and health and fitness facilities.

In the Cattle Market car park a large Traders' Market is held on Wednesdays and Saturdays. A thriving Farmers' Market is held in the City Centre pedestrian precinct every two weeks on a Friday between 9am and 2pm.

Shopmobility

This scheme improves access to Chichester City Centre, giving greater independence to people with limited mobility. Shopmobility operates between 9am and 3pm on Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday from East Pallant Car Park.

Parking for Disabled Persons

To help people with disabilities gain easy access to the City, most pay and display car parks have specially allocated parking spaces. These spaces, along with any others in the pay and display car parks, can be used free of charge provided the vehicle is displaying a valid disabled person's badge and the registered disabled person is driving or is a passenger. Blue (Disabled) Badge holders may use on street City Centre voucher parking spaces or specially allocated spaces adjacent to the pedestrian area, with no time limit or payment.
