

Ride 3

Amphill - Haynes

Distance: 8.9 miles/14.3km

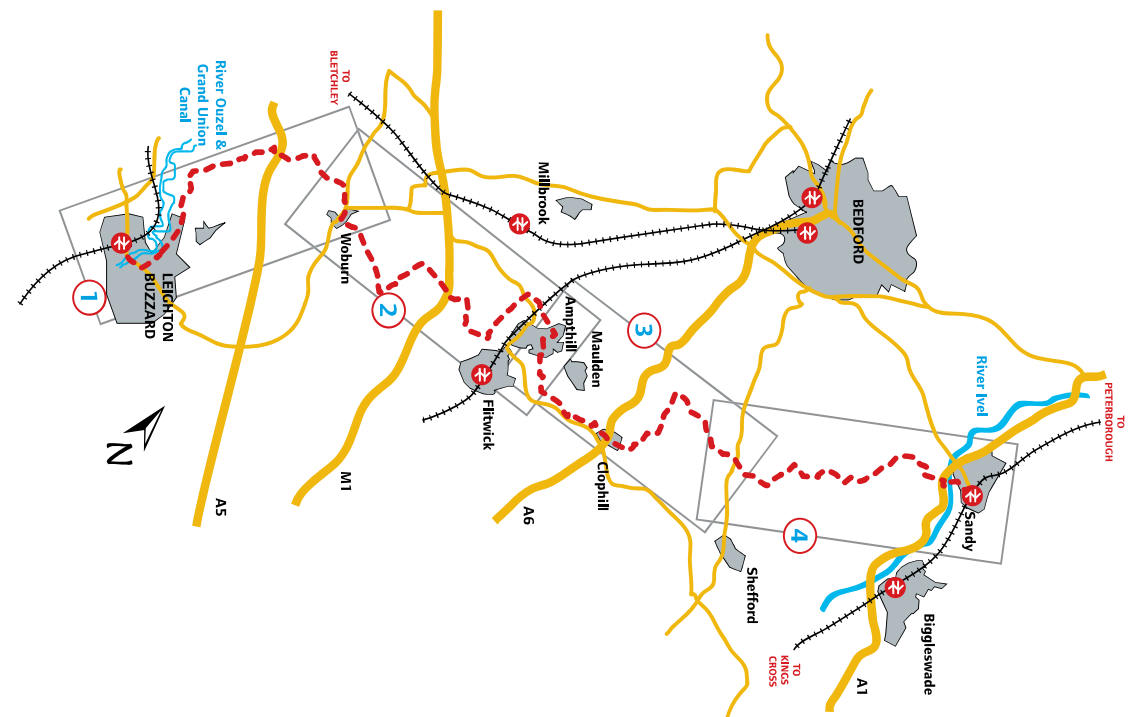
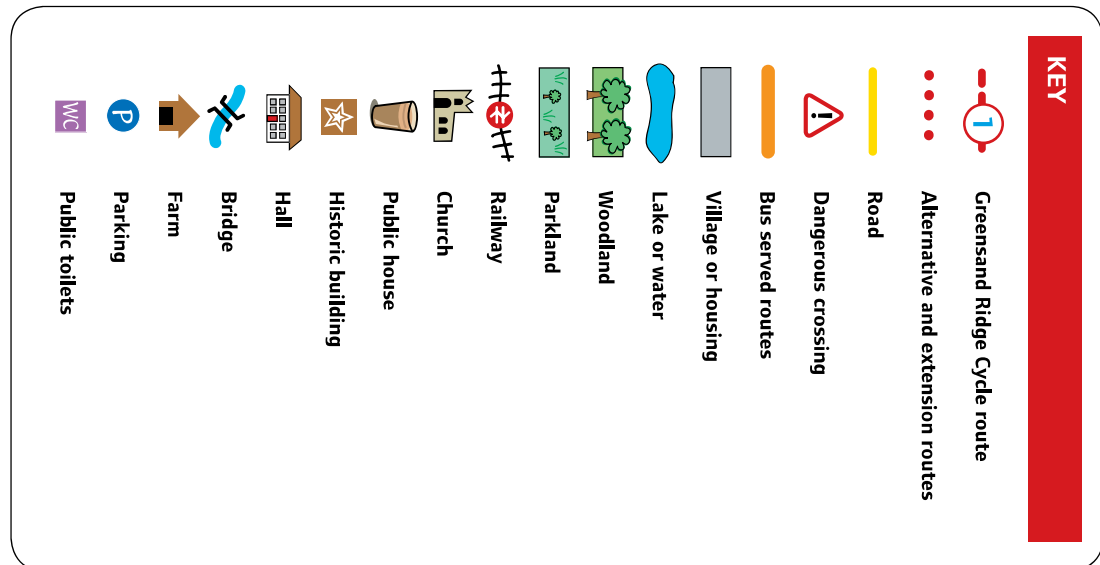
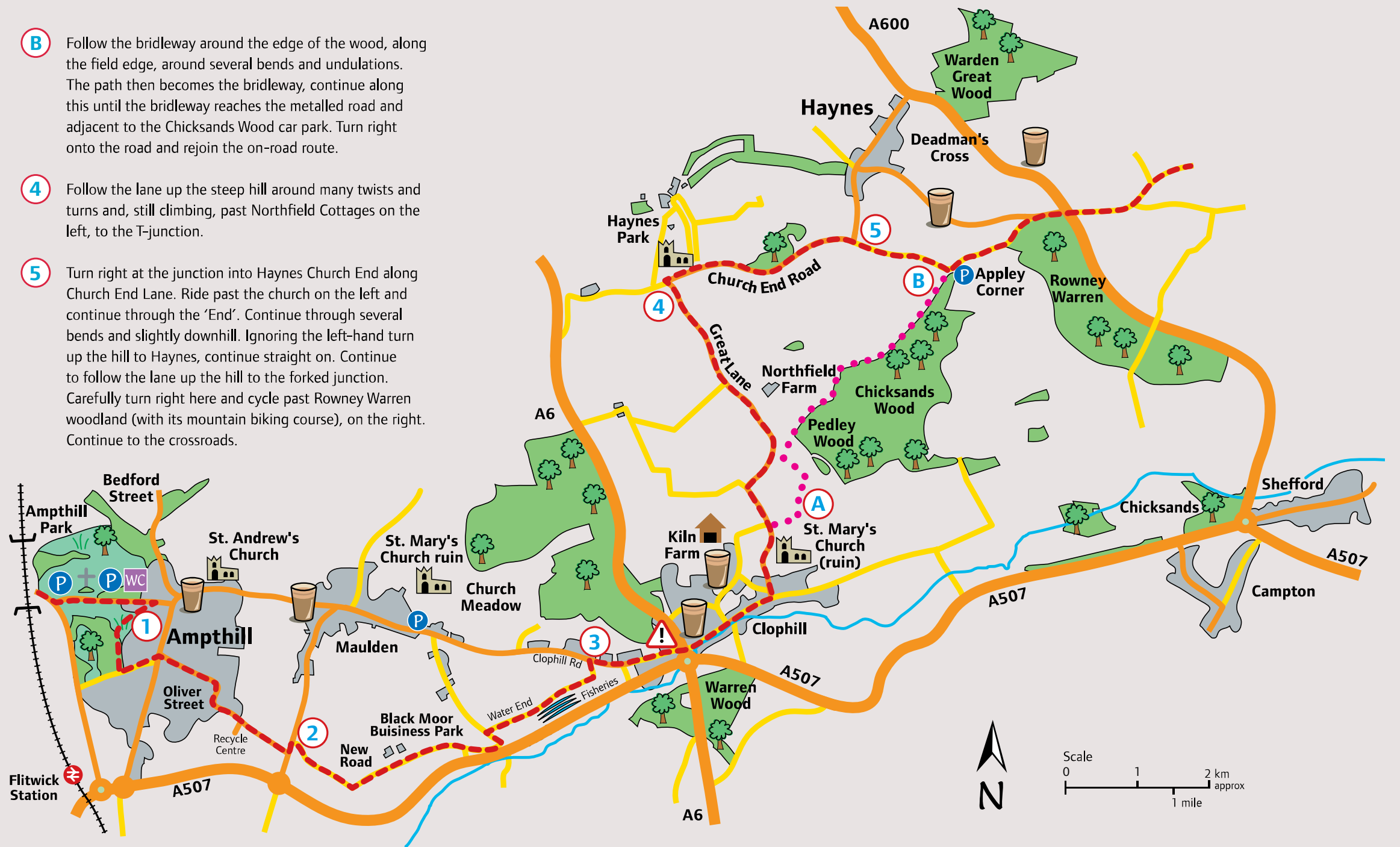
- 1 Cycle into the town centre, and turn right at the double mini-roundabouts and head along Dunstable Street, past the Old Sun PH on your left. At the next mini-roundabout turn left down Oliver Street and follow the road out of Amphill past the Recycling Centre (on the right).
- 2 Cycle as far as the T-junction, turn left then take the first right along New Road. Follow New Road past Black Moor Business Park then around the sharp left hand bend and turn right into Water End Road. Cycle through the small hamlet of Water End, past the Fisheries on the right, around the sharp left-hand bend, past Water End Farm and continue to the T-junction.
- 3 At the T-junction turn right onto Clophill Road, then at the right hand bend turn left continuing on Clophill Road. At the T-junction cross the A6 very carefully using the centre island and into the village of Clophill. Ride past the Flying Horse PH and along the High Street. After approximately 900m turn left into Great Lane (just before the church).

ALTERNATIVE OFF-ROAD ROUTE

Clophill - Haynes

- A Cycle up Great Lane, up the hill, past Kiln Lane on the left and around the sharp, right hand bend. 200m past the bend turn across the road, to the right and along BWA1 towards Chicksands Wood.

- B Follow the bridleway around the edge of the wood, along the field edge, around several bends and undulations. The path then becomes the bridleway, continue along this until the bridleway reaches the metalled road and adjacent to the Chicksands Wood car park. Turn right onto the road and rejoin the on-road route.
- 4 Follow the lane up the steep hill around many twists and turns and, still climbing, past Northfield Cottages on the left, to the T-junction.
- 5 Turn right at the junction into Haynes Church End along Church End Lane. Ride past the church on the left and continue through the 'End'. Continue through several bends and slightly downhill. Ignoring the left-hand turn up the hill to Haynes, continue straight on. Continue to follow the lane up the hill to the forked junction. Carefully turn right here and cycle past Rowney Warren woodland (with its mountain biking course), on the right. Continue to the crossroads.
