

**COMMENTS on P4C Forest Centre to Lidlington Checked 6/4/2017**

References to identified numbers on the published leaflet on the website.

- Number 1 - Coming from the pergola and turning right down the bridleway there is **NO** picnic table. The surfaced track leading to Station Road splits soon after the start when a new track created by contractor's traffic goes off to the left while the correct Forest Park track continues straight to the kissing gate. It is easy to take the wrong track here and you need to keep right on the established track which has recently been upgraded.
- Number 3 - After the level crossing you need to turn right and cross the road where there is a finger post at the entrance to Granary Wood.
- Number 4 - At the first finger post you need to continue **LEFT** around the base of the mound then climb up to the left end of the fence. Where you climb steps onto waymarked track the continuation path with trees on the right has a **fallen sign** in the hedge bottom. After encountering the 'PRIVATE' sign the track to the right has **NO STEPS**.
- Number 5 - From the railway crossing the tracks across cultivated fields pick up the signs for the Timberland Trail which are easy to follow back to the Forest Centre
- Number 6 - The text refers to a right hand path 15 yards into the field. This is incorrect, You need to take the **LEFT** hand path and after that the printed instructions are satisfactory.
