### General Terms and Conditions 2020

1. Entry fees will not be refunded to players withdrawing from the tournament.
2. All entries must be received by 1 June, entries received after this date cannot be guaranteed a place within the Tournament. Name and address details of entrants will be retained until December 31<sup>st</sup> 2018 after which time it will be confidentially destroyed.
3. Dress for all games up to semi finals will be white tops and grey trousers for men and grey trousers or skirts for the ladies. Club & County shirts can be worn but all members of team must be the same. (Football shirts not allowed)
4. All competition winners will be paid by BACs transfer and must provide bank details on completion of finals

### Tournament Terms and Conditions 2020

5. If a player fails to appear on the rink within 15 minutes of the time appointed for play, he/she may be disqualified and any complete team failing to arrive within the time limit will forfeit all rights to any prize money on offer.
6. No substitute will be allowed for singles competitions, and only one substitute will be allowed in all other events. At least one person's name must be on the original entry form. The team originally named in the first game of any competition will be deemed to be that team's entry. No person named in the programme for a competition can transfer from one team to another.
7. Mixed Pairs, Mixed Triples, Over 60's Open Singles and Pairs which begin in round robins: Substitutes will be allowed to ensure that the required number of games are played, and when a substitute is used, the scorecard must be marked against that person's name by the skip and on the master scorecard in each round until that team has been beaten.
8. Failure of a team to complete their full fixtures could mean exclusion from future competitions and any game not played will mean a score of 10-4 will be entered as the result.
9. When an extra end has to be played, the skips will toss for the cast of the jack and the mat placed as for the first end and this procedure will be adopted on all extra ends thereafter.
10. Single 21 up; pairs 21 ends; triples 18 ends: fours 21 ends.
11. In all games the official scorecard must be billed in and signed by both skips and returned to the office as soon as possible to allow the Tournament Manager time for the next issue. The winning skips should return both cards.

### PRIVACY NOTICE
