FESTIVAL TERMS & CONDITIONS – VEHICLE EXHIBITORS

1. The event site will be open to all exhibitors from 07:30. Exhibitors will be notified of whether to enter the site from the North or South end of the event site. Please show your booking confirmation on entry.
2. Pre-booked vehicles should arrive before 8:30 to allow time for stewards to direct/escort you to your position within the event site.
3. Limited vehicle access will be allowed on site after 09:00 until after the event closes for the day.
4. The festival will be officially open to the public from 10:00 on both days.
5. On Saturday the event will close to the public at 18:00 and on Sunday will close at 16:00. Exhibitors are requested not to leave before this time in the interests of public safety. Should you need to leave in the event of an emergency please contact the steward of your exhibition area who will arrange to have your vehicle escorted out of the event site.
6. Following the official close each day, exhibitors must wait for the all clear to be given by event management before any vehicles are moved. The event site will need to be cleared of visitors before this announcement is made.
7. Any vehicles which are not an integral part of the display must be removed from the site on each morning of the event before 09:00.
8. All vehicular entry routes will be closed at 09:30 on both days of the event and only pedestrian or emergency vehicle movement will be permitted until the event closes for the day and the visitors have left.
9. The organisers reserve the right to remove unauthorised vehicles from the site and to charge the owners for the removal costs.
10. All exhibitors must clear their vehicles from the site before 18:00 hours on Sunday.

SITE SECURITY

1. A limited security presence will be provided overnight from 19:00 to 07:00 on Friday and Saturday nights but no guarantee can be given as to the safety of vehicles, goods or equipment due to the length of the event site. No liability will be accepted by the event or GYBC.
2. All exhibitors should ensure they have their own insurance in place.

SAFETY

1. Exhibitors must adhere to the festival terms and conditions.
2. All designated emergency access routes must be kept clear at all times.
3. In the event of fire or other emergency it may be necessary to evacuate the site. The instructions of the Stewards and the GYWF event team should be followed
4. Rubbish should not be allowed to accumulate on the site. Please dispose of your rubbish before leaving the event site.
5. The speed limit for all vehicular movements on the site is five miles per hour. Anyone not adhering to this request may be asked to leave the event site and will be unable to return.
