

THE SPA TRAIL

Walk, cycle or ride the Spa Trail - 4 miles of flat, surfaced path and bridleway along the mid section of the old Horncastle to Woodhall Junction railway line & part of the Horncastle canal.

This easy, traffic free route is ideal for wheelchair users and families with young children and pushchairs.



The trail, part of the Viking Way long distance path, passes through woods and rolling countryside. Sculptures made from wood, stone and metal are scattered along the way, reflecting local wildlife and links with the past.

Access points:

You can join the trail at these access points. Limited car parking is available:

Sandy Lane, Woodhall Spa
situated off the B1191, 2 miles from Woodhall Spa village centre

Martin
situated near Martin Bridge on the B1191 between Horncastle and Woodhall Spa

Thornton Lodge, near Horncastle
situated on the minor road off the A153 1¹/₄ miles south of Horncastle town centre

Horncastle
trail accessible from the canal footbridge by the Swimming Pool situated on Coronation Walk near the town centre.

Walkers can continue via public footpath into Woodhall Spa and Horncastle.
