## NOTES FOR APPLICANTS

#### A: CRITERIA AGAINST WHICH APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED:

- Applications will be considered which assist community based leisure/cultural activities in support of the 'UCI Road World Championships' which will be of benefit to local communities in Bradford & District. Please read the application cover note for details of grants.
- 2 Special consideration will be given to particular target groups including the elderly, youth, ethnic minorities, unemployed, special needs organisations, and to particular communities (eg; inner city areas, council estates), and for new starts and innovatory schemes.
- 3 Applications from organisations outside the boundaries of the City of Bradford Metropolitan District council will not be considered for this one off initiative.
- The maximum allocation of this community grants would be £250. If you would like to discuss a route animation initiative with bigger visual impact that costs slightly more than the community grant offered please get in touch with <a href="mailto:saira.ali@bradford.gov.uk">saira.ali@bradford.gov.uk</a> to discuss your idea.
- 5 Projects should not contravene Council policy guidelines in areas of equal rights (eg; policies regarding gender, equality, ethnic minorities, special needs).
- The organisation should be a non-profit making voluntary organisation where membership is open (i.e. no discrimination of membership on grounds of sex, race, religion, occupation or opinion).
- 7 All awards are one-off.

# The following will not normally be supported:

- Promotion of non cultural/leisure activities
- Fund-raising events
- Services funded normally from other sources (e.g. commercial interests, voluntary contributions or public sector provision)
- Requests for capital projects
- Requests for retrospective support
- Treats, outings and guest speakers will not be funded
- Requests from students either for course fees or projects which could be considered as part of their course study
- Requests from single schools

- 6. Please note the dates of this year's UCI World Championships are 21–29 September 2019. Bradford will host the Start of the Elite Women Road Race on Saturday 28 September 2019 and the Men Elite Road Race will come through Ilkley and Addingham on Sunday 29 September.
