The Royal Connection- Queen Victoria

Throughout 2019 the whole country will celebrate the 200th anniversary of Queen Victoria's birth making it the perfect time to visit the film set in Hull and to discover a little more about Hull's historic connections to Victoria.

Hull was delighted with the opportunity to provide some stunning locations on Hull's Historic High Street for filming of the 3rd series



ITV's Victoria starring Doctor Who's Jenna Coleman. This award winning series based on the life of one of Britain's most influential monarchs Queen Victoria, whose reign spanned an impressive 63 years from 1837 to 1901



1854 saw the first royal visit to Hull in more than 200 years. Queen Victoria, Prince Albert and their young family stayed at the Railway Hotel. This grand Victorian building on Ferensway changed its name to the Royal Hotel after the visit. Today, visitors to the Britannia Royal Hotel can stay in the room from which she waved to the crowds, and see the two remaining rose-tinted windows Queen Victoria ordered for her visit.

The whole city embraced the visit and resulted in many monuments and tributes which are still visible today

Visit Queen Victoria Square and Statue where Victoria sits on her throne above the public convenience which is a theme throughout the city to have royal statues quite literally sat on the throne.


Wander through Queens Gardens, a tranquil sanctuary for wildlife in the heart of busy city centre. Queens Gardens was once the largest dock in the country. Originally named The Old Dock, it was renamed Queens Dock in 1854 to coincide with the royal visit.

Shopping is taken to another level at Princes Quay Shopping Centre. Built on stilts over *Prince's Dock* the former historic dock named after Prince Albert. Its large windows offer visitors panoramic views of the Hull Marina and the dock.



Just over 1 mile from the city centre Pearson Park is home to two 35ft marble Statue of Victoria and Albert unveiled 1903. During Victoria's reign the park formed part of Hull's Botanical Gardens and still resonates with Victorian grandeur, features including a conservatory greenhouse and Grade II listed East Lodge and an ornamental gateway.

Offering stunning views across the Humber Estuary Victoria Pier provided Queen Victoria the perfect setting in this maritime city to knight general surgeon and Hull mayor Henry Cooper during the royal visit in 1854.

Trinity Market and Hepworth Arcade



In the heart of the Historic Old Town Trinity Market is home to a dazzling array of local independent traders, a large market hall with cutting edge street food vendors as well as traditional grocers of fruits, vegetables and meat.

The market hall holds a large communal urban eating area and which hosts regular events including live music and exhibitions.



Hepworth Arcade is a Unique 'L' shaped Victorian Arcade completed in 1897. Originally home to one of the first penny bazaars opened by Mr Marks and Mr Spencer. This Grade II Listed Arcade is better known for local landmarks such as Dinsdale's joke shop, Fanthorpe's television store and Beasley's fashion emporium. It is a welcome retreat for shoppers escaping

the rain to shelter under its glass roof, often to peruse the quirky independent retailers who offer something a little out of the ordinary you would never find in the high street.
